Civility Squad Grants Because It Matters

Overview

Civility begins with our daily interactions—in our schools, our workplaces, and elsewhere in our day-to-day lives.

As part of our Because It Matters regional civility initiative, Gulf Coast Community Foundation invites you to join The Civility Squad by applying for a Civility Squad Grant. "Mini grants" of up to \$500 will be awarded to help businesses and organizations in our region implement civility programs within their agency, school, workplace, or other venue.

Timeline

Civility Squad Grants are available from October 10, 2017, to February 28, 2018.

<u>Guidelines</u>

- Organizations applying for a mini grant will need to provide a one-page outline of their civility project, including a plan of impact and sustainability.
- The grant may cover all or part of the expense of implementing a civility-related project.
- Once a grant is awarded, the project must be started within 4 weeks.
- A brief video showing your civility project in action must be submitted to Gulf Coast within the same time frame.

Approval

- Civility Squad Grant applications will be considered on a rolling basis. Once you apply, you should hear back within two weeks!
- Only one Civility Squad Grant application will be considered per business or organization.
- Applying for or receiving a Civility Squad Grant will not preclude the grantee from being eligible for other Gulf Coast grant opportunities.
