Each session of the *Gulf Coast Board Institute* welcomes individuals who participate in four interactive training experiences over a four-week period.

Through the *Gulf Coast Board Institute*, participants are provided with a comprehensive overview of governance issues as well as in-depth exploration of key governance topics.

All components of the *Gulf Coast Board Institute* are provided at no cost to participants.

- Becoming an ambassador for your organization
- Financial and legal oversight responsibilities
- Fundraising and resource development
- Board / Chief Executive Partnership
- Creating a diverse, highly functioning and engaged board

Selection Process

Participants will be selected through a competitive process with the intent of creating a group of individuals with a variety of experiences.

Regardless of prior board experience, all participants should possess a personal commitment to use what they learn through the *Gulf Coast Board Institute* to strengthen the governance capacity of a nonprofit organization in the Gulf Coast region.
